

# CROCHET BASKET WEAVE DISHCLOTH

## THE SNUGLERY

### PATTERN

**Starting chain:** For this dishcloth pattern, ch 28 (multiple of 6+4).

**Row 1:** Skip the first 3 chs, 1dc in 4th ch and each rem ch.

**Row 2:** Ch 2, turn. Skip first dc and \*fpdc each of next 3 sts. Bpdc each of next 3 sts\* Rep between \*\* to the last st of the row, 1dc in turning ch.

**Row 3:** Rep row 2.

**Row 4:** Ch 2, turn. Skip first dc and \*bpdc each of next 3 sts. Fpdc each of next 3 sts\* Rep between \*\* to the last st of the row, 1dc in turning ch.

**Row 5:** Rep row 4

Repeat rows 2-5 (four row repeat) for a total of **16 rows** or until your dishcloth is as long as you'd like it to be!

### ABBREVIATIONS

**dc**= double crochet **ch**=chain **fpdc/bpdc**=front post/back post double crochet  
**st(s)**=stitch(es) **rep**=repeat



### MATERIALS

For this pattern you'll need about 75 yards (70 m) of a cotton, worsted weight yarn like Red Heart Scrubby Smoothie or Paintbox Yarns Cotton Aran. I used a 6mm hook to ensure an open weave that would dry quickly when actually using the dish cloth! This creates an 8" by 8" (20cm by 20cm) dish cloth that is adjustable to your preferred size.
