

# KNIT BASKET WEAVE DISHCLOTH

## THE SNUGLERY

### PATTERN

To begin, cast on 37sts (multiple of 8\*5)

**Row 1:** K all sts

**Row 2:** K 5, \*p 3, k 5\* rep between \*\* to the end of the row.

**Row 3:** P 5, \*k 3, p 5\* rep to the end of the row.

**Row 4:** K 5, \*p 3, k 5\* rep between \*\* to the end of the row.

**Row 5:** K all sts

**Row 6:** K 1, p 3, \*k 5, p 3\* rep between \*\* to the last st, k 1.

**Row 7:** P 1, k 3 \*p 5, k 3\* rep between \*\* to the last st, p 1.

**Row 8:** K 1, p 3, \*k 5, p 3\* rep between \*\* to the last st, k 1.

Repeat rows 1-8 until your piece measures 20" (50cm).



### MATERIALS

For this pattern you'll need about 75 yards (70 m) of a cotton, worsted weight yarn like Red Heart Scrubby Smoothie or Paintbox Yarns Cotton Aran. I used 5mm needles to ensure an open weave that would dry quickly when actually using the dish cloth! This creates an 8" by 20" (20cm by 50cm) dish cloth that is adjustable to your preferred size.

### ABBREVIATIONS

**k**= knit **p**=purl **rep**=repeat **st(s)**=stitch(es)
