

The Snugglery recipe

hooded cowl

SKILL LEVEL
beginner

OVERVIEW

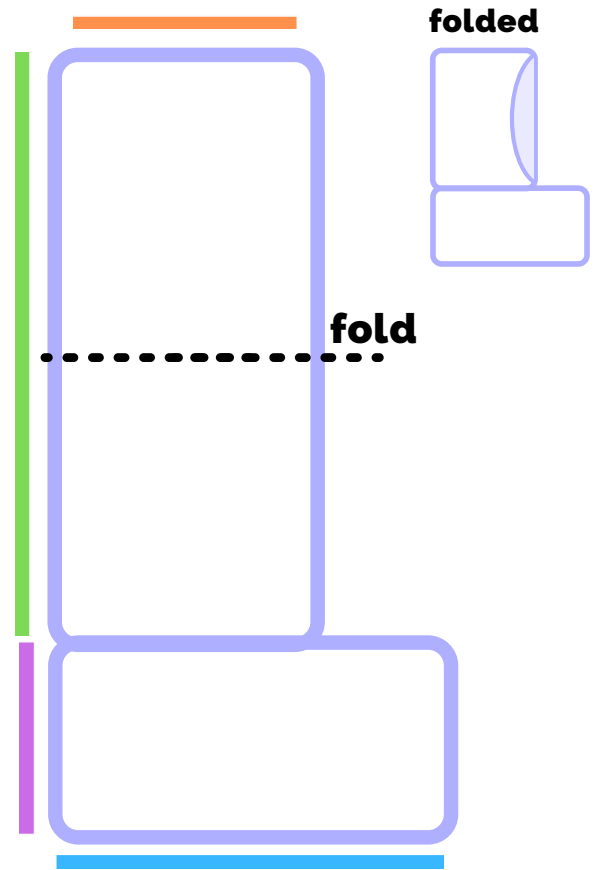
this is one, very beginner friendly way to make a hooded cowl in any size, with any stitch

the hood is a simple rectangle you can add to an existing cowl pattern

first, seam one short side of the rectangle to the top edge of the cowl

then, fold the rectangle and seam the other side to the cowl

finally, seam up the back edge of the hood



KEY



*double 'cowl length' = circumference

SIZING

	baby	child	adult S	adult L
hood length	20" (50 CM)	23" (60 CM)	26" (66 CM)	28" (77 CM)
hood depth	7" (18 CM)	8" (20 CM)	9" (23 CM)	10" (25 CM)
cowl length	8" (20 CM)	9" (23 CM)	12" (30 CM)	13" (33 CM)
cowl height (*adjustable)	4" (10 CM)	5" (13 CM)	7" (18 CM)	8" (20 CM)

*cowl height is suggested but you can make it as thick as you'd like!
