

The Snugglery recipe

wrist warmers

SKILL LEVEL
beginner

OVERVIEW

this is one, very beginner friendly way to make wrist warmers/fingerless gloves in any size, with any stitch

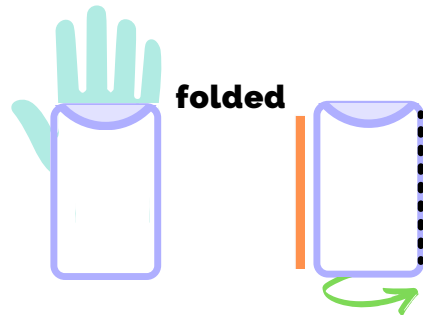
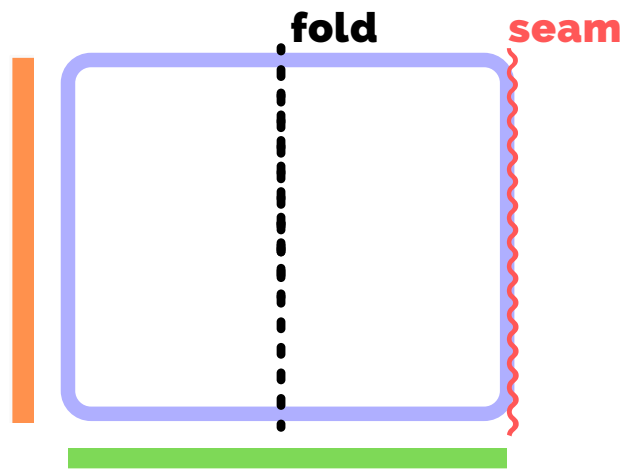
the glove is a simple, nearly square, rectangle

first, cast on or chain the number of stitches that will be the length of your piece

then, work in any stitch until you reach the width of your desired size (wrist circumference)

finally seam first and last rows together

optionally, leave a small thumb hole



KEY



length will determine how long your wrist warmers are up the arm

width determines wrist circumference

thumb measurement below is for both size and position (from the top edge)

SIZING

	baby	child	adult S	adult L	
length*	4.5" (12 CM)	5" (13 CM)	6" (25 CM)	7" (20 CM)	
width	5" (13 CM)	6" (15 CM)	7" (18 CM)	8" (20 CM)	
thumb	opening	1" (3 CM)	2" (5 CM)	2.5" (6 CM)	3" (8 CM)
	distance from edge	0.5" (2 CM)	1" (3 CM)	2" (5 CM)	2.5" (6.5 CM)

*glove length is suggested but you can make it as long or short as you'd like!
